Attendance

We have only 63 school days left this year!! You will receive attendance information at the beginning of next term.

Why is Attendance Important?

Children who are in school and on time every day do better than those who are not. It's a fact. Even children whose attendance is 90% will have missed 19 school days over the year and will struggle to achieve their targets. So here is what we do to encourage good attendance at Donington Cowley Endowed Primary School.

Weekly

Arlo the school dog will spend time with the class with the highest attendance

Yearly

Every child who achieves 100% attendance for the whole year will receive a certificate on the last day of the school year.

What do I do if my child is ill?

If your child is absent from school, please phone us or log the absence on ParentMail as soon as you can. For safety reasons, we operate a thorough absence monitoring procedure, so early notification is crucial.

Where a fixed penalty notice may be issued...

Fixed term penalties will only be issued in circumstances where the LA is satisfied that the criteria for prosecution would be met if the option of a fixed penalty notice is not taken up by the parent. The circumstances in which a notice may be issued are:

- Where a child is absent from school due to unauthorised absence of 10% or over a sixweek period.

- Where a child is present in a public place during school hours without reasonable justification during the first five days of any exclusion.

Statutory Assessments

KS2 SATs (Year 6s)

These statutory assessments take place from Monday 13th May to Thursday 16th May 2024 and includes a Reading paper, Spelling, Punctation and Grammar and 3 maths papers which are spread over the four days. On these days, the Year 6s can come to school and have breakfast before they complete the tests.

Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) (Year 4s)

The MTC takes place over a two-week period starting on Monday 3rd June. The test takes approximately 15 minutes and the children will have opportunities to practise beforehand. The sound check on TTRS also allows the children to practise the style of questions.

Phonics Screening (Year 1s)

There is a phonics screening check for all Year 1 children which takes place during the week beginning Monday 10th June and takes approximately 20 minutes.

Parking reminder

Please can all Parents and Carers be mindful as to where they park at school drop off and collection times. There are an increasing number of vehicles parking on the yellow, zigzag lines outside of school which is extremely dangerous for the children and parents/carers

coming to and from school as it causes an obstruction.
