More about our topic...

This term in year 1 and 2 we will start by taking part in a 2 week geographical study. We will expand our geographical knowledge and study our local area.

After this, we will be moving onto an exciting new topic called 'Read all about it.' This is a fascinating topic and we will cover: The Great Fire of London, Guy Fawkes and the study of Columbus and America as well as many other exciting events.

With so many exciting learning opportunities, this topic is going to be memorable!

Pupils will extend their historical knowledge by sequencing events, looking at sources and comparing the past to now.

As well as 'The Green Ship' we will also be looking at the work of Anthony Browne and his wordless picture books.



#### **English**

In English, we will be improving our grammar, language and ability to write for different purposes through our topic. Some of the exciting writing opportunities this term include looking at diaries, information texts about Donington and stories with familiar settings.

Our class book this term is 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake. A super book which links to our learning.

Reading for pleasure and enjoyment will lie at the heart of our English curriculum. Children will be involved in using a wide range of texts, linked to topic. They will take part in group discussions and will be encouraged to share their own views and reading interests. Through discussion and questioning comprehension skills will be developed, enabling children to increase understanding and appreciation of literature. Opportunities within all

areas of the curriculum will be made available for children to develop their spoken language through discussion, drama and presentations.



#### Maths

Maths will be taught as an individual subject and will continue to adhere to the curriculum objectives. Teaching will enable children to become fluent in arithmetic as well as being able to reason and problem solve. Maths lessons will cover all aspects including, understanding number, using all four operations, measurement, fractions and statistics. Pupils will be extended at every opportunity to ensure their potential as mathematicians is achieved.

To prepare for our new topic, it would be brilliant if the children could research their local area. They could make note of any landmarks, draw pictures, take pictures or even write down some facts about where they live!
