Literacy

We continue striving to embed a love of reading from a young age, this is supported through our curriculum. Over the next two terms we have some lovely key texts that link to our carefully planned topics that we will be sharing with the children as well as encouraging children to seek out their favourite stories from our reading area to share and retell with the grownups and their peers.

We have also introduced the children to our special reading bee Barney, who spends weekends at the houses of children who have gone above and beyond with their learning that week. He is thoroughly enjoying his adventures and looks forward to meeting all the new children.

We will also be spending some time in our incredible outdoor library 'Robin's Nest'

Maths

In maths the children will continuing their exploration of numbers, learning and understanding a new concept of positional language, as well as extending their knowledge of patterns.

We will continue supporting children with rhymes and songs to support both their literacy and maths development.

Shake, Rattle and Roll

Our first topic of the year allows the children to continue leaning about themselves and those around them. It also explores expression through music, exposing children to rhymes and poems.

Into the woods

As we head into Spring, we will extend the children's learning on seasonal change. Spotting those first signs of spring and enjoying the excitement of new life, from plants and animals. The children will explore different woodland animals and understand how they are different to animals within their homes.
