


Donington Cowley Endowed Primary School Newsletter

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As you will know, the Government has announced that the lifting of the national lockdown will now be delayed until 19th July. With this in mind, I would like to thank you all for continuing to wear face coverings when coming on to the school premises. Your help and support in keeping the school community safe is very much appreciated.

Tues 20th July – 10:30 a.m. Leavers' assembly. This will hopefully be held outdoors, on the school field. Parents/carers of our Year 6 pupils are welcome to join us.

Please note that all planned activities are subject to change.

This year, each class within Reception to Year 5 will have the opportunity to enjoy an activity day specifically designed for the class by their teacher. Each teacher will

let you know when the class activity day is to take place and what the children might need to bring to school! We are very excited!

Each class will also have the chance to enjoy a class sports' day within the class bubble. The house points from each class will be added up to provide the grand total! Please note that the sports' events will be children only events this year and will not be open to visitors. Hopefully next year, everything will be back to normal and we will have a full calendar of summer events.

Please continue to be vigilant about COVID-19. **If your child or anyone in your household has any of the symptoms of COVID-19, they must not come to school.** The current Government guidance around testing and self-isolation must be followed. If a child presents with any of the symptoms of COVID-19 whilst at school, they will be isolated from other children and we will contact you straight away so that the child can be collected. At this point, a test should be booked and we would ask that the results are shared confidentially with the school. Pupils and staff who are sent home due to COVID-19 symptoms will only be allowed to return to school once the test results are received or the designated period of self-isolation is followed.
