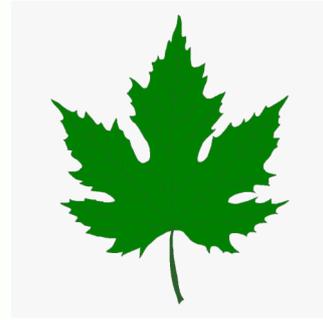


Sycamore Class Newsletter

Welcome

We will be using Class Dojo as a reward system for the class. It is an interactive resource where children can accumulate do-jo points for different aspects of their work e.g. being on task, great answers, changing reading books regularly, handing homework in early.

Children will collect the points and when they reach a certain amount they can be converted into house points for their team colour.



Reading

Reading is very important., especially in Year 1 where we are extending our phonics and vocabulary knowledge.

We read in class on a daily basis and encourage the children to regularly read at home, every night if possible. Reading books and reading diaries can be checked and changed on any day of the week. We still need the books and reading diaries to be brought into school even if the book is not finished so we can keep our records up to date.

Children will follow our school reading scheme until they are ready to move onto the **Accelerated Reader Programme**. The Accelerated Reader is an online system that children use when they have finished reading a book, it asks them questions to check their understanding of the book they have read.

Children will also be able to choose a book from school to bring home and share with you. This will be a picture book for you to read together, these will be changed once a week, on a Friday. This can be recorded in their reading diary but remember, this is a book to enjoy together and an aid to instilling a love of reading with the children.

Over the term the children will be introduced to **MyOn**. MyOn is an online reading platform linked to Accelerated Reader. There are thousands of online books that the children will be able to access and read.

Reading is the key to all our education endeavours; thank you for all your support with home reading.
