 - 2. Silver Award- 75% of the school classes participate.**
 - 3. Bronze Award- 50% of the school classes participate.**



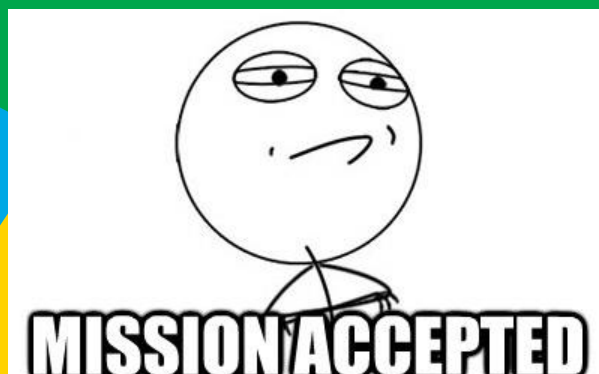
