

Welcome back! I hope everyone has had a fantastic half term and have had the opportunity to make the most of the improved weather- it is lovely to start to see the first signs of spring emerging. This half term, whilst short, is looking very busy with lots of exciting things happening in school.

Reading

We have recently undertaken a review of our whole school approach to reading and have signed up to the Lincolnshire Reading Pledge. Our aim is to ensure all children have opportunity to develop a love of reading along with the knowledge and skills needed to read fluently and thereby confidently access the full curriculum.

Working with the English Hub we have developed a reading spine which sets our recommended reads for each year group - these can be accessed on our website <u>The Donington Cowley Endowed Primary - Reading</u>. Our curriculum is aligned with key texts for whole class shared reading and additional opportunities to encourage children who are accessing Read Write Inc Phonics to read texts for pleasure in addition to their decodable 'book bag books'. For those no longer following the scheme, a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts have been appropriately banded for children to enjoy in school and at home. We encourage you to read with your child at all opportunities - You are never too old for a bedtime story!!



In school we have enjoyed different reading events to further enhance children's reading experiences, these have included paired reading - between different age groups and shared story telling with adults across the school. Children have greatly enjoyed these opportunities and are looking forward to forthcoming activities and events including World Book Day (Thursday 2nd March) and Shakespeare Week (Week beginning 27th March).

Attendance and Punctuality

We politely remind you that all children should be in school by 8.55am. If your child is unwell and unable to attend school, we must receive notification by this time each day of absence. Notification can be made by Parent Mail, email or telephone. Failure to do so may lead to a home visit or referral to external services as per our attendance and safeguarding policy and procedures.
