Words

As part of their year in EYFS, your child will be given a set of high frequency words for you to practise at home with them. Each week, usually on a Thursday, we check that your child can read the words confidently before moving them on to the next set of words.

Tapestry

Tapestry is up and running. You are warmly invited to comment on any school posts and add your own posts too in relation to your child's learning experiences.



Homework

Homework is given out on a Friday and needs to be back on the following Thursday for marking. Alternatively, homework can be photographed and emailed to me or uploaded onto Tapestry.
